Why host a screening?

Hosting an informal screening of *From One Village* for peers, colleagues, a civic group, school or place of worship is a great way to spread the word about the plight of children in Uganda and the difference the Arlington Academy of Hope is making. Just follow these six easy steps.

1 Think through logistics and invite your guests.

Who will you invite? Where and when will you hold your screening? Send out emails to get the ball rolling. See our website for sample email invitations.

2 Tell us about your event!

Contact us 10-14 days before your event so we can send you the *From One Village* DVD and AAH brochures. Please let us know when you will hold your screening, the organization or group that you're hosting it for, how many people you expect and your mailing address and phone number. (Note: you can also stream the documentary from the AAH website rather than use the DVD.)

3 Learn about AAH's programs and background info.

Read the AAH fact sheet for a quick overview of the organization and Uganda or check out the AAH website.

4 Use the AAH talking points provided.

The talking points sheet includes suggested remarks for before and after showing the film, as well as what to say to the audience members who ask how they can help.
